Community Behavioral Health Center (CBHC)

The Brien Center Community Behavioral Health Center (CBHC) plays a vital role in enhancing the well-being of our community. Through accessible services, comprehensive care, crisis intervention, community education, and collaborative efforts, we contribute significantly to the mental health landscape in Berkshire County. We create spaces where individuals can receive the support they need.

Services provided by The Community Behavioral Health Center (CBHC):

- Individual and Group Therapy:
 - Provides counseling sessions for individuals and groups to address various mental health issues.
- Crisis Intervention:
 - Immediate support and intervention for individuals experiencing a mental health crisis or emergency. Adult and Youth Mobile Crisis Response- 24/7.
- Medication Management:
 - Evaluations and ongoing management of medications for mental health conditions.
- Substance Use Disorder Treatment:
 - Programs and services for the treatment of substance use disorders, including counseling and rehabilitation support.
- Case Management and Support Services:
 - Assistance with accessing community resources, support with housing, employment, and social services to help individuals manage their mental health conditions effectively.
